The course consists of lecture and a final exam.

CALCTP is a statewide initiative aimed at increasing the use of lighting controls in commercial buildings and industrial facilities. CALCTP partner utilities (such as So. Cal. Edison) will require CALCTP-certified contractors and general electricians on these projects in order to qualify for incentives.

If your company has already fulfilled the CALCTP <u>Business</u>

<u>Development Course</u> requirement, then completion of the
Systems course will satisfy the final requirement needed for
CALCTP certification. <u>See reverse for information on how many employees must complete the course for the company to
